Credential Utilization	Validates which certifications improve employability and income potential.	Compare credential completion data with job placement data.
	Informs decisions on curriculum updates and resource allocation.	Link credentials earned to career outcomes for longitudinal analysis.
Post-Graduation Pathways	Provides insights into diverse outcomes like employment, higher education etc.	Deploy structured follow-up forms to capture if the students are choosing to go to job market, college or other vocational programs.
